



## QUARTZ COMPOSITE SINK CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

### Method 1) Quick Cleaning:

- Plug the sink drain.
- Add 300-500 ml (10-17 ounces) of undiluted BLEACH.
- Using gloves, gently clean the surface with a soft sponge.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.

### Method 2) Soaking (shown below):

- Plug the sink drain.
- Fill the sink with hot water and add 300-500 ml (10-17 ounces) of Sodium Hypochlorite Bleach 4.5%.
- Let it sit for 30-60 minutes.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- **Wear gloves during this process.**



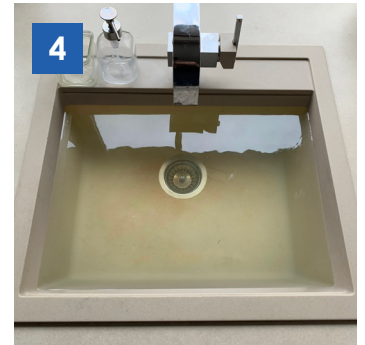
1 Plug sink drain



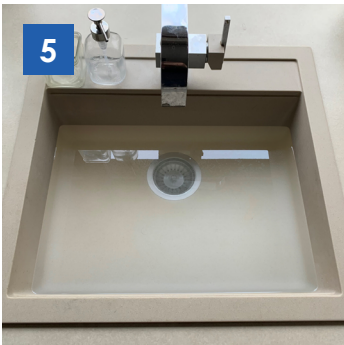
2 Fill with hot water



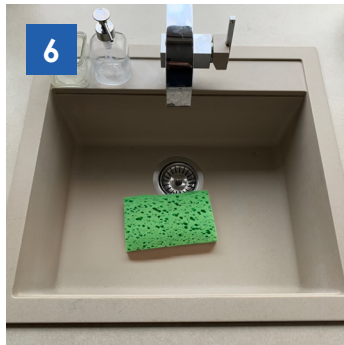
3 Pour 10-17 oz. bleach



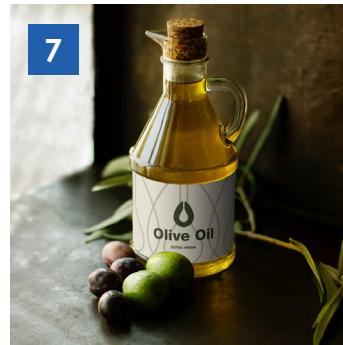
4 Let sit 30-60 min.



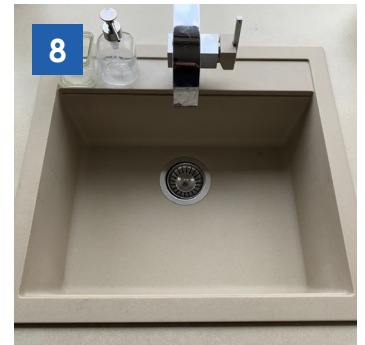
5 Drain after 30-60 min.



6 Wipe dry



7 Apply olive oil



8 Enjoy beauty

### After cleaning:

Apply olive or mineral oil to the surface; **\*Make sure to dry it beforehand.**

By cleaning this way, you will avoid the need for scrubbing the sink surface. Scrubbing the sink can reduce the protective resin layer, exposing the quartz, which is more porous and is more easy to trap dirt particles. This is true for quartz composite sinks from all major manufacturers. Bleach helps remove bacteria and dirt, and applying oil afterward will protect the surface for 3-5 months, depending on usage.

**Note:** This method is not suitable for limescale deposits, which are usually white, not brown.
